TITLE OF THE MASTER : MASTER IN SUSTAINABLE CITIES IN AFRICA OF THE UNIVERSITY OF LOME		
<p>GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF THE MASTER</p> <p>The master's degree is obtained after two years of research work leading to the defense.</p> <p>To this end, this Master's program in sustainable cities from the regional center of excellence on sustainable cities in Africa (CERViDA - DOUNEDON) aims to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -To train students in fundamental and applied research in design and implementation of sustainable cities. -To train students in basic and applied research in the design and implementation of sustainable urban development projects in Africa. 	<p>ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:</p> <p>The entry to the master program in sustainable city in Africa is subject to the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -To hold a Bachelor's degree, a Master's degree or a Master's degree in sociology, geography, anthropology, sanitation and water, environment, land use planning, architecture, urban planning, urban management, civil engineering, electrical engineering, earth or life sciences or any other equivalent degree; -Have a minimum of 12/20 overall average; -Having a research background or previous work in the field would be an asset and not a prerequisite. 	<p>WORKING LANGUAGES:</p> <p>The CERViDA DOUNEDON training program is a dual program. All candidates must have an intermediate level in English for French-speaking candidates and an intermediate level in French for English-speaking candidates.</p> <p>NB: For candidates from English-speaking countries, French courses will be offered during the training at CERViDA. The same applies to candidates from French-speaking countries who wish to improve their level of English.</p>
<p>SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE OF THE TRAINING</p> <p>At the end of the training at CERViDA -DOUNEDON, students should be able to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use the techniques and tools necessary for research, space analysis and the elaboration of urban projects; -Understand the challenges of urban development in order to produce strategic and operational planning tools at the scale of cities and metropolises; -Design projects and strategies to reduce the difficulties of access to basic services and facilities; -develop projects integrating HQE (High Environmental Quality) construction techniques and processes -Evaluate the environmental and social impact of human activities in urban areas 	<p>CONSTITUTION OF THE FILE :</p> <p>Applicants for the master program in sustainable cities in Africa must provide the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - One (01) motivated request addressed to the president of the university of Lomé on the background and fields of interest of the candidate; - one (01) legalized copy of the transcripts and certificate of diploma (from the Baccalaureate); - One (1) copy of the valid student card, national identity card or passport; - One (01) detailed curriculum vitae with three references; 	<p>PROGRAM OVERVIEW</p> <p>The time required for the training in Master Sustainable Cities in Africa is four (4) semesters without extension.</p> <p>The program is available on the CERViDA website.
